

SEC. 15. Whoever violates any of the provisions of the six preceding sections shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$25 for the first offense and not more than \$100 for each subsequent offense. Penalty.

AMENDING ACT RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

AN ACT relating to elections and amending section 1385 of Ballinger's Annotated Codes and Statutes of Washington.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. At all elections where national, state, county or municipal officers are elected, the polls shall be opened at eight o'clock A. M. and closed at eight o'clock P. M.: *Provided*, That in precincts outside of incorporated towns and cities the hour of opening of said polls shall be nine o'clock A. M., the hour of closing 7 o'clock P. M. Opening and closing of polls.
