SEC. 3. All fees collected under the provisions of this act shall be paid over to the state treasurer and deposited in the state treasury to the credit of the current fund of the grant of which the lands from which such fees are collected, form a part. Fees.

FISCAL BIENNIUM.

AN ACT fixing the fiscal biennium.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. The fiscal biennium of the state shall commence on the first day of April in each odd-numbered year and end on the thirty-first day of March of the next succeeding odd-numbered year.
