WHEN CONTRACT FOR SALE OF GOODS IS VOID.

An Act relating to the sale of goods, wares and merchandise and repealing Section 2326 of the Code of Washington Territory of 1881.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Statute repealed.

Section 1. That section 2326 of the Code of Washington Territory of 1881, (section 7746 of Pierce's 1919 Code) is hereby repealed.

INSPECTION OF OILS.

An Act relating to illuminating oils and repealing certain acts in relation thereto.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Statutes repealed.

Repeal not to operate as revivor. Section 1. That chapter 187 of the Laws of 1903, pages 394-396, and chapter 192 of the Laws of 1907, pages 412-418, are hereby repealed: *Provided*, That the repeal of said acts shall not be construed as reviving any acts or parts of acts amended or repealed by any thereof.
