

## CHAPTER 24.

[ H. B. 53. ]

CONVEYANCE OF SHORELANDS IN BENTON  
COUNTY TO KENNEWICK.

AN ACT authorizing conveyance of certain shore lands in Benton County from the state of Washington to the city of Kennewick and authorizing the commissioner of public lands to convey the same by appropriate deed.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:*

SECTION 1. The commissioner of public lands of the state of Washington is hereby authorized and directed to certify, in the manner prescribed by law, to the governor for deed to the city of Kennewick the following described first class shore lands to-wit:

Lots thirteen to twenty both numbers inclusive, of Kennewick shore lands, as surveyed, established and platted, according to plat thereof filed in the office of the commissioner of public lands February 28th, 1913: *Provided*, That this conveyance is made upon the express condition that the lands hereby conveyed shall be used as a public park, and if such lands are ever converted to other use, then said land shall revert to the state of Washington.

SEC. 2. The governor is hereby authorized and directed to execute, and the secretary of state to attest, a deed to the city of Kennewick conveying all of said shore lands.
