RELOCATION OF HARBOR LINES IN LIBERTY BAY.

AN ACT authorizing the relocation of harbor lines in Liberty Bay in Kitsap county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. The board of natural resources, acting as the harbor line commission provided for in Article XV, section 1 of the Constitution of the state of Washington, is hereby authorized to change, relocate or re-establish harbor lines in Liberty Bay in front of the town of Poulsbo in Kitsap county, as shown on the official map of Poulsbo Tidelands filed in the office of the commissioner of public lands on May 15, 1916. Harbor lines to be re-established.
