CHAPTER 1.

[S. B. No. 21.]

LEGISLATIVE EXPENSES.

AN ACT appropriating the sum of eighty thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the expenses of the Eighth Legislature.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That there be and there is hereby appropriated out of the funds of the State of Washington, the sum of eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used for the expenses of the Eighth Legislature of the State of Washington. Legislative expenses.

Approved by the Governor January 20, 1903.

CHAPTER 2.

[S. B. No. 20.]

FOR THE RELIEF OF MRS. JOHN R. ROGERS.

AN ACT for the relief of the widow of the late Governor of the State of Washington, His Excellency, Governor John R. Rogers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of any moneys, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of five hundred eighty-nine 55-100 dollars, to re-imburse Mrs. John R. Rogers for the funeral expenses paid by her in connection with the funeral of her late husband, His Excellency Governor John R. Rogers, who died in office. Appropriation for funeral expenses.
