

CHAPTER 91.

[H. B. 28.]

LEGISLATURE.

An Act changing the boundaries of the 3rd and 4th senatorial and the 2nd and 3rd representative districts in Spokane County.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That Section thirty-one (31) of township twenty-six (26) north, of range forty-four (44) east, and that portion of section six (6) of township twenty-five (25) north, of range forty-four (44) east, lying north of the Spokane River, be, and the same is hereby, taken from the area composing Riverside precinct in the 3rd senatorial district and the 2nd representative district, and be, and the same is hereby, added to, made a part of and incorporated into the area of Pasadena precinct, situated in the 4th senatorial and 3rd representative district.

CHAPTER 92.

WIRELESS TELEGRAPH STATION.

An Act authorizing cities of the first class maintaining a harbor department to install, maintain and operate wireless telegraph stations in connection therewith.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. Any city of the first class maintaining a harbor department is hereby authorized to install, maintain and operate in connection therewith
