

CHAPTER 13.

[S. B. 117.]

WASHINGTON STATE PENITENTIARY.

AN ACT making an appropriation for the Washington State Penitentiary for the deficiency created in restoring, and for completion of, buildings damaged by fire of September 3rd, 1926, and declaring that this act shall take effect immediately.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated for the Washington State Penitentiary from the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the following sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary:

FROM THE GENERAL FUND.

Deficiency.	For the deficiency created in restoring and reconstructing buildings damaged by fire of September 3rd, 1926.....	\$ 70,147.41
Reconstruction.	For completion of work of restoring and reconstructing buildings damaged by fire of September 3rd, 1926.....	29,852.59
	Total	\$100,000.00

SEC. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, for the support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take effect immediately.
