

CHAPTER 230.

FLOOD CONTROL MAINTENANCE FUND.

AN ACT appropriating one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) from the General Fund to aid counties which shall establish flood control maintenance funds.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Appropriation from general fund.

Flood control with counties.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the State of Washington the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the Department of Conservation and Development, Division of Flood Control, to be used for state participation in flood control projects and maintenance where counties shall appropriate not less than one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the cost of such maintenance, under chapter 204, Laws of 1941 (sections 9625, 9626, 9627 and 9663F-1 to 9663F-7, both inclusive, Rem. Supp. 1941).
