

CHAPTER 256.

[H. B. 398.]

RELATING TO MINING CLAIMS.

AN ACT relating to mining claims, repealing section 1, chapter XLVI, Laws of 1893, State of Washington (section 8618 Remington's Revised Statutes, also Pierce's Perpetual Code 738-7); and declaring that this act shall take effect immediately.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That section 1, chapter XLVI, Laws of 1893, State of Washington (section 8618 Remington's Revised Statutes, also Pierce's Perpetual Code 738-7), be and the same is hereby repealed. Act repealed.

SEC. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and the support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take effect immediately. Effective immediately.
