Notices of election shall contain a description of the territory proposed to be transferred, the names of the counties from and to which such transfer is intended to be made, and shall be posted and published as required for general elections.

SEC. 2. That section ten of said act be and the same is ^{Repeal.} hereby repealed.

DEFICIENCY APPROPRIATION FOR SALARIES OF DEPUTY FISH COMMISSIONERS.

AN ACT making a deficiency appropriation for salaries for
Deputy Fish Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the Fish Hatchery Fund the sum of four hundred dollars for Deputy Fish Commissioner's salaries for the remainder of the fiscal year ending March 31st, 1903.
