CREATING A STANDARD SIZE OF CERTAIN FRUIT BOXES.

AN ACT to create and establish a standard size of certain fruit boxes for the State of Washington.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created and established a standard size for apple boxes and pear boxes for the State of Washington.

SEC. 2. The standard size of an apple box shall be ^{Standard size.} eighteen inches long, eleven and one half inches wide, ten and one-half inches deep, inside measurement. The standard size of a pear box shall be eighteen inches long, eleven and one-half inches wide, eight inches deep, inside measurement.
