CHAPTER 28.

[House Bill No. 59.]

APPROPRIATION FOR NATIONAL GUARD.

AN ACT appropriating the sum of thirty-six thousand six hundred and eighty dollars, from the military fund, for maintenance of the National Guard.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Appropriation \$36,000. SECTION 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated out of the military fund the sum of thirty-six thousand six hundred and eighty dollars, for maintenance of the National Guard of Washington.

CHAPTER 29.

[House Bill No. 60.]

FOR RELIEF OF INDIAN WAR VETERANS.

AN Act for the relief of the Indian War veterans of the wars of 1855 and 1856.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That there be and hereby is appropriated Appropriation \$10,000. Appropriation out of the general funds in the treasury of the State of Washington the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), or so much thereof as shall be necessary, to pay the veterans of the Indian wars of 1855 and 1856, who served under and by virtue of the directions of the officers of Washington territory, for their said service, under the conditions and upon the terms hereinafter provided.

Allowances.

SEC. 2. That each non-commissioned officer and private who served the Territory of Washington in the Indian wars of 1855 and 1856 shall be entitled for such service [to] the sum of \$2.00 per day for himself, and all commissioned officers shall receive such sum as was paid to officers of the same rank of the army of the United State at said time: *Provided*, That any amount paid on account thereof by the United States shall be deducted therefrom.
