ACTION FOR MAINTENANCE OF ILLEGITIMATE CHILDREN.

AN ACT relating to illegitimate children and repealing Sections 1214 to 1221, both inclusive, of the Code of 1881.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Section 1. That sections 1214 to 1221, both instatute clusive, of the Code of Washington Territory of 1881, are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 12.

REGULATION OF OCCUPATION OF BARBERING.

An Act relating to the practice of barbering and repealing Chapter 172 of the Laws of 1901 and Chapter 84 of the Laws of 1913.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Section 1. That chapter 172 of the Laws of Statute repealed. 1901, pages 349-352, and chapter 84 of the Laws of 1913, pages 258-259, (Secs. 413-427 Pierce's 1919 Code) are hereby repealed.
