FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICTS.

AN ACT relating to fire protection districts; and amending section 1, chapter 34, Laws of 1939, as amended by section 1, chapter 70, Laws of 1941 (section 5654-101, Rem. Supp. 1941).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. Section 1, chapter 34, Laws of 1939 as amended by section 1, chapter 70, Laws of 1941 (section 5654-101, Rem. Supp. 1941), is amended to read as follows: Amendments.

Section 1. Fire-protection districts for the elimination of fire hazards and for the protection of life and property from fire in territories outside of incorporated cities and towns are hereby authorized to be established as in this act provided. Fire protection districts authorized.
