WEED EXTERMINATION AREAS—RULES AND METHODS.  
AN ACT relating to noxious weeds; and amending section 17.08.070, R.C.W.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:*

Amendment.

SECTION 1. Section 17.08.070, R.C.W., as derived from section 3, chapter 194, Laws of 1937, is amended to read as follows:

Methods and rules may be modified.

Methods and rules to be followed in extermination areas may be changed or modified by the authority setting up the areas whenever in their judgment a change is justified, practical, and in the interest of the public welfare. Upon the determination of methods, rules and regulations to be followed in any area, the boards and the director shall publish such methods, rules, and regulations weekly for three consecutive weeks in a newspaper published in the county in which the area is located and of general circulation in the county.
