CITIES OF FIRST CLASS—MAYOR, LEGISLATIVE BODY.

AN ACT relating to the compensation and time to be devoted to the performance of the duties of the mayor and members of legislative bodies of first class cities.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. The compensation and the time to be devoted to the performance of the duties of the mayor and members of the legislative bodies of all cities of the first class shall be as fixed by ordinance of said city irrespective of any city charter provisions. Compensation
