

CHAPTER 10.

APPROPRIATION—LEGISLATIVE BILL DRAFTING.

AN ACT relating to the statute law committee; making an appropriation; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the general fund, for the permanent statute law committee, to carry out the provisions of section 6, chapter 257, Laws of 1953, salaries and wages, the sum of thirty thousand dollars, or as much thereof as is necessary to pay the additional cost of preparing and drafting bills for the legislature. Appropriation.

SEC. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate support of the state government and its existing public institutions and shall take effect immediately. Emergency.

Passed the House January 26, 1959.

Passed the Senate January 27, 1959.

Approved by the Governor January 30, 1959.

CHAPTER 11.

MOTOR VEHICLES—STAGGERED REGISTRATION.

AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; deferring the effective date of chapter 261, Laws of 1957, pertaining to a staggered registration system of licensing and staggered payment of the excise tax thereon to January 1, 1962; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. Sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, chapter 261, Laws of 1957, and RCW 46.16.400, 46.16.410, 46.16.420, 46.16.430, and 46.16.440 shall not take effect Effective date,
