STATE FERRIES—LUMMI ISLAND TO ORCAS ISLAND.

- AN ACT relating to the Puget Sound ferry system; and authorizing and directing the Washington toll bridge authority to establish and operate a ferry service from Lummi Island to Orcas Island.
- Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Ferry service authorized. SECTION 1. The Washington toll bridge authority is hereby authorized and directed to establish and operate a ferry service from a suitable point on Lummi Island in Whatcom county to a suitable point on Orcas Island in San Juan county by the most feasible route if and when Whatcom county constructs a bridge from Gooseberry Point on the mainland to Lummi Island. The actual operation of such ferry service shall not begin until Whatcom county has completed the construction of such bridge.

STATE FERRIES—TARIFFS AND CHARGES.

- An Act relating to the Washington state ferries, providing for a review of certain operations thereof, the appointment of an advisory committee, and declaring an emergency.
- Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Review of charges authorized. SECTION 1. The Washington toll bridge authority is hereby authorized and directed to review tariffs and charges as applicable to the operation of the
