## CHAPTER 60.

[Substitute House Bill No. 936.]

## PUBLIC ASSISTANCE—DISABILITY ASSISTANCE.

AN ACT relating to the state government and its existing public institutions; allocating state funds to eligible disability assistance applicants and recipients; making an appropriation; and adding new sections to chapter 26, Laws of 1959 and to chapter 74.10 RCW.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

New section.

Section 1. There is added to chapter 26, Laws of 1959 and to chapter 74.10 RCW a new section to read as follows:

Public assistance—Disability assistance —Eligibility. The department of public assistance is authorized to disregard as income of every eligible recipient of disability assistance under the provisions of this chapter an amount not exceeding fifty dollars of the first eighty dollars earned in any single month by such recipient as follows:

- (1) The first twenty dollars earned by any eligible recipient is wholly exempt, and shall not be considered as a resource within the definition and application of this title;
- (2) Fifty percent of any amount earned by such eligible recipient in excess of twenty dollars but not exceeding eighty dollars, is exempt to such eligible recipient and shall not be considered as a resource within the definition and application of this title;

- (3) Every earned amount in excess of eighty dollars shall be considered a resource within the meaning of this title.
- Sec. 2. There is added to chapter 26, Laws of New section. 1959 and to chapter 74.10 RCW a new section to read as follows:

It is the intent and purpose of this chapter that Purpose. eligible recipients of disability assistance be given rehabilitation incentives by which they may make a better life for themselves and for their families, and in order that they may contribute productive energies benefiting the state and nation.

Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the general Appropriation. fund to the department of public assistance for the biennium ending June 30, 1969, the sum of ninetyfive thousand dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary in order to make the disability assistance grants directed under the provisions of chapter 74.10 RCW.
