

## Women Legislators in the Washington State House and Senate

In 1910, ten years before women's suffrage became the law of the land, Washington women gained the right to vote. Three years later, in 1913, two women became members of the House. Now there are 50 state women legislators, 34% of the total 147 legislative seats. Congress's average is 19.4%; the [50-state legislative average](#) is 24.5%.
