

Daniel J. Evans Governor

Daniel Jackson Evans (Republican) is presently serving his first term as governor of the State of Washington. The 16th governor of the state was born in Seattle, Washington, October 16, 1925. In both World War II and the Korean War, he served as an officer in the United States Navy. Between the wars, he completed his education at the University of Washington with a B.S. in 1948 and an M.S. in 1949; both degrees being in Civil Engineering. After several years in private engineering practice, he began in 1960 a four-year partnership in a civil and structural engineering firm. Between 1956 and 1964, he served four terms as a state representative from King County's 43rd District. The last two terms he served as Republican floor leader. Governor Evans and his wife, Nancy Ann, have three boys.




INTRODUCTION

John Andrew Cherberg (Democrat) will be serving his sixth term as President of the Senate and Chairman of the Senate Rules Committee. He was first elected Lieutenant Governor in 1956 and reelected again in 1960 and 1964. Born in Pensacola, Florida, in 1910, he received a Life Teaching Diploma from the University of Washington in 1934. Formerly a teacher and athletic coach, he is presently a television executive. Atwood, R. Frank (Republican) Senator from the 42nd District (Whatcom County) will be serving his third session, second term. Born in 1926 in Massachusetts. Graduated with a B.A. in Political Science from W.S.U. and L.L.B. University of Washington Law School. He is an attorney, Veteran of World War II, Major in Army Reserve. Member Lions, Elks, Y.M.C.A., Chamber of Commerce, and past member of Bellingham City Council. He and his wife, Marie, have three children.



Bailey, Robert C. (Bob) (Democrat) Senator from the 19th District of Pacific and part of Grays Harbor County. Served in the House for three terms and is serving his third term in the Senate. Canfield, Damon R. (Republican) For 14 years Representative from the 15th District; the first Senator from new District 8. Educator, fruit and cattle rancher. Born Arkansas 1897, attended Seattle Public Schools, U. of W., graduated W.S.U. 1921. Member Methodist Church, Masons, Navy veteran WW I, Pres. Central Washington Fair, and other farm and civic organizations. He and his wife Marie have a son and daughter.



Chytil, Joe (Republican) Senator from the 20th District of Lewis County. Served in the House in 1953-55-57 and 59. Started in the Senate in 1961, will be serving his fourth session in the Senate. Born in Aberdeen in 1909. A graduate of high school and business college. Has been in radio broadcasting since 1937, and a member of the board of Washington State Association of Broadcasters. Member of the Elks, Eagles and Rotary. He and his wife Jane have two children.

Cooney, John L. (Democrat) Senator from the 5th District of Spokane County. He has served two terms in the House and is serving his second term in the Senate. Born in 1915 in Condon, Oregon. Graduated from Gonzaga Law School and is a practicing attorney. Member Elks, Eagles, Grange, Knights of Columbus and Garland Businessmen's Association. He and his wife Marguerite have four children.



Connor, Frank (Democrat) Senator from the 33rd District of King County served three terms in the House and will be serving his fourth term in the Senate. Born in Seattle in 1916. Donohue, Dewey C. (Democrat) Senator from the 10th District of Columbia, Asotin and Garfield Counties. Has served six terms in the House and is serving his second term in the Senate. Dore, Fred H. (Democrat) Senator from the 37th District of King County. Served 7 terms in the House and will be serving his 4th term in the Senate. Served as Interim Committee Chairman of the Education Committee from 1962 to 1964 and as Chairman of the Interim Committee on Facilities & Operations from 1964-66. Attended Seattle University and graduated from Georgetown Foreign Service School and Georgetown Law School and is a practicing lawyer. He and his wife Mary have five children.

Faulk, Lawrence John (Republican) Will be serving his first term in the Legislature as a Senator from the 26th District of Pierce County. He and his wife Mary have one child.


