Supported Innovative Pilot Projects – All projects seeded by support from the ACCT program and still going today . . .

Mobility coordinators – *Information is often mentioned as a barrier to transportation. In response ACCT has sponsored and developed a handful of mobility coordinator positions around the state. Mobility Coordinators know about all the transportation options and programs available to people and can put people in touch with the right programs. They can also be used to leverage changes among the different local programs.*

Homeless student transportation – *With the help of an earmark grant secured by Senator Patty Murray's, we supported a series of pilot projects focusing on effective ways to provide transportation for homeless students to get to school.*

Beyond the borders – *Set in rural Pierce County outside of the transit boundary, this partnership between the State, County, Transit System, and Medicaid brokerage is true coordinated transportation and feeds people into the urban area.*

School bus/transit/nonprofit partnerships – *In Mason County the transit and school districts formed a project where the transit uses school buses for public bus routes that benefit student attending after school programs.*
