## Statewide Transportation Needs Assessment

The Washington State Legislature has commissioned a comprehensive assessment of statewide transportation needs and priorities over the ten-year timeframe of 2022-2031.

The study includes:

### Statewide Transportation Needs Assessment

- Categorical estimates of annual needs and potential gaps between regular expenditures and need, organized by type of investment, type of jurisdiction and region, and State Transportation Policy Goal.
- A short list of high-impact transportation projects that must be addressed at the state level because of extraordinary scale, scope, and/or cost.

### Funding Options

- A funding model of current and potential transportation revenue sources, showing the funding available by jurisdiction type and expenditure type.

### Economic Impact

- 10-12 case studies that describe how different types of transportation projects impact communities across the state, with quantified fiscal benefits to impacted jurisdictions with annotated additional benefits.

### Facilitation of Appointed Body

- Work with a JTC Executive Committee appointed body to review the needs assessment and priorities so they can draft recommendations to the Legislature for consideration during the 2021 session.
