- Improvements in client health status and wellness; (**1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 17, 18, 19, 20**)
- increases in client participation in meaningful activities; (**25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31**)
- reductions in client involvement with criminal justice systems; (**32, 33, 34, 35, 36, and 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42**)- #32 & #37 *2nd phase for DBHR*
- reductions in avoidable costs in hospitals, emergency rooms, crisis services, and jails and prisons; (**9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36**)
- increases in stable housing in the community; (**7, 21, 22, 23, 24**)
- improvements in client satisfaction with quality of life; (**7, 10, 21, 23, 25, 26, 27, 31, and 43-51** survey items) *HCA to include questions addressing 43, 44, and 47 into other existing surveys*
- and reductions in population-level health disparities." (potential overlay for all measures)
