

## **ROLE AND COMPOSITION OF THE HVAC/R BOARD**

---

ESSB 5831 (as passed House) would have established a 13-member HVAC/R Board.

### **Board's Role**

The Board would have been authorized to:

1. Conduct proceedings for denying applications, suspending or revoking certificates, and imposing penalties;
2. Approve expenditures; and
3. Advise the Department of Labor and Industries on HVAC/R matters.

### **Board's Composition**

The members of the Board would have been:

- Four certified mechanics with at least one, but not more than two, from eastern Washington, and at least one from a border county;
- Four licensed HVAC/R contractors with at least one, but not more than two, from eastern Washington, and at least one from a border county;
- One public member familiar with HVAC/R work;
- One building operator representing the commercial property management industry;
- One member from the stationary operating engineers;
- One member from a technical college or an apprenticeship training program; and
- One building official familiar with enforcement of HVAC/R work.
