**HB 1795** - S COMM AMD

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
2 following:

3 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The health care authority, department of  
4 social and health services, and department of health shall collaborate  
5 to identify goals and benchmarks while also developing individual  
6 agency plans to reduce the incidence of diabetes in Washington, improve  
7 diabetes care, and better control the medical complications and  
8 financial impacts associated with diabetes.

9 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** The health care authority, department of  
10 social and health services, and department of health shall submit a  
11 coordinated report to the governor and the appropriate committees of  
12 the legislature by December 31, 2014, and every even-numbered year  
13 thereafter, on the following:

14 (1) The financial impacts and reach that diabetes of all types and  
15 undiagnosed gestational diabetes are having on the programs  
16 administered by each agency and individuals, including children with  
17 mothers with undiagnosed gestational diabetes, enrolled in those  
18 programs. Items included in this assessment must include: (a) The  
19 number of lives with diabetes and undiagnosed gestational diabetes  
20 impacted or covered by programs administered by each agency; (b) the  
21 number of lives with diabetes, at risk for diabetes, and family members  
22 impacted by prevention and diabetes control programs implemented by  
23 each agency; (c) the financial toll or impact diabetes and the  
24 complications it places on these programs; and (d) the financial toll  
25 or impact diabetes and its complications, and diagnosed gestational  
26 diabetes and the complications experienced during labor to children of  
27 mothers with gestational diabetes places on these programs;

28 (2) An assessment of the benefits of implemented and existing  
29 programs and activities aimed at controlling all types of diabetes and

1 preventing the disease. This assessment must also document the amount  
2 and source for any funding directed to each agency for the programs and  
3 activities aimed at reaching those with diabetes of all types;

4 (3) A description of the level of coordination existing between the  
5 agencies on activities, programmatic activities, and messaging on  
6 managing, treating, or preventing all types of diabetes and its  
7 complications;

8 (4) A development or revision of detailed policy-related action  
9 plans and budget recommendations for battling diabetes and undiagnosed  
10 gestational diabetes that includes a range of actionable items for  
11 consideration by the legislature. The plans must identify proposed  
12 action steps to reduce the impact of diabetes, prediabetes, related  
13 diabetes complications, and undiagnosed gestational diabetes. The  
14 plans must also identify expected outcomes of the action steps proposed  
15 in the following biennium while also establishing benchmarks for  
16 controlling and preventing all types of diabetes; and

17 (5) An estimate of savings, efficiencies, costs, and budgetary  
18 savings and resources required to implement the plans identified in  
19 subsection (4) of this section.

20 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** Sections 1 and 2 of this act constitute a  
21 new chapter in Title 70 RCW."

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22 On page 1, line 2 of the title, after "Washington;" strike the  
23 remainder of the title and insert "and adding a new chapter to Title 70  
24 RCW."

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
