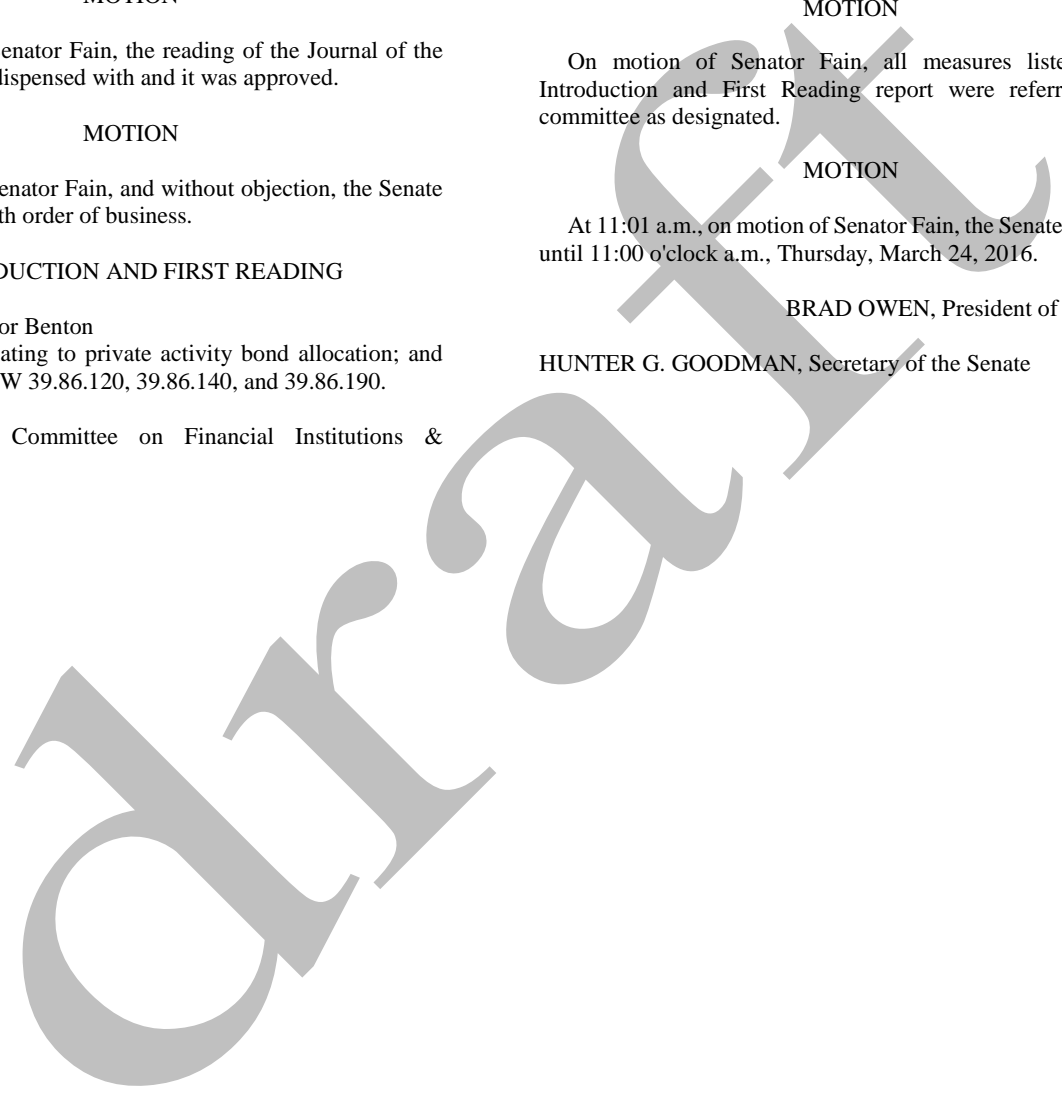
On motion of Senator Fain, all measures listed on the Introduction and First Reading report were referred to the committee as designated.
