2014 Session Wrap Up – Bipartisan Success

- Tuition at state colleges and universities will not increase for the second year in a row, which hasn't happened since 1981, due to the Senate's prioritization of education.
- This year's budget update allowed us to build on progress from last year by prioritizing education spending with 2 of every 3 new dollars going to early learning, K-12 and higher education.
- The budget update was the most bipartisan plan in decades with 90% of legislators in support.
- Respecting the will of taxpayers for the state to live within its means led to a sustainable budget that meets Washington's four-year balanced budget requirement.
