# JLARC's Infrastructure Assignment

➤ What is infrastructure?

- "The basic installations and facilities on which the continuance and growth of a community or state depends."

- In 2005, the Legislature directed JLARC to assemble an inventory of state grant and loan programs that assist local governments and others develop infrastructure.



# JLARC's Inventory of State Grant and Loan Programs for Infrastructure


- 75 programs
- 20 agencies
- More than \$1 billion in grants and loans in 2005 (state & federal \$)
- Inventory designed for two audiences:
  - Legislators
  - Potential program applicants
