

Joint Center for Aerospace Technology Innovation Sunset Review



In 2012, the Joint Center for Aerospace Technology Innovation (JCATI) was created to:

Pursue joint industry-university research in new technologies relevant to aerospace.

Enhance education of university engineering students through industry-focused research.

Work with aerospace firms and industry associations to identify research needs.



JCATI



Provides grants to Washington's public universities for industry-focused aerospace research.

Legislature appropriated \$3M to JCATI in the 2017-2019 biennium.

JCATI funds approximately 16 grants annually.

Grants range from \$30,000-\$127,000

Has a Governor appointed board of directors and is located at UW.

JCATI is subject to the Sunset Act

(RCW 43.131)

JCATI will automatically terminate in 2020 unless the Legislature reauthorizes it.

Sunset Act directs JLARC to review entities in the year prior to termination date.
