Agency Summary	The Boating Facilities Program provides grants to state and federal agencies, local governments, tribes, and other entities to develop, plan, and renovate public boating facilities for motorized boats, including launch ramps, guest moorage, and support facilities. Grant applications to the Recreation and Conservation Funding Board are ranked and submitted for funding consideration.
