An Act appropriating money for the maintenance of the soldiers' home

Whereas, There have been paid into the general fund of the state treasury by the treasurer of national home for disabled veteran soldiers, sums aggregating three thousand eight hundred and nineteen  $\frac{2.3}{1.0.0}$  dollars (\$3,819.23): therefore,

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the general fund of the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the maintenance of the state soldiers' home the sum of three thousand eight hundred and nineteen  $\frac{2.3}{1.00}$  dollars (\$3,819.23).
