CHAPTER XIX. [H. B. No. 320.]

APPROPRIATION FOR IMPROVEMENTS AT UNIVER-SITY, PENITENTIARY AND AGRICULTURAL COL-LEGE.

AN ACT providing for the construction, repair, improvement and equipment of buildings for the university of Washington, the agricultural college and school of science and the state penitentiary, and making an appropriation therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Sundry appropriations for state institutions. SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall severally be found necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys from the general fund of the state treasury for the repair, equipment, improvement and construction of the state buildings hereinafter set forth, viz.:

FOR UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON.

Building two dormitories, one for ladies, one for gentle-

men, not to exceed \$25,000 each	\$50,000	00
For equipment and furnishing of said two dormitories	5,000	00
For equipment of sewerage system of university build-		
ings	5,000	00
FOR STATE PENITENTIARY.		

For building dining hall and kitchen..... \$6,000 00

FOR AGRICULTURAL COLLEGE AND SCHOOL OF SCIENCE. For rebuilding and furnishing boys' dormitory...... \$40,000 00

For the construction of a large shop and foundry and the construction and furnishing of a biological laboratory, to be known as Science Hall, sixty thousand dollars, which said appropriation of sixty thousand dollars shall be repaid to the state from the proceeds of the first sale of lands belonging to the school of science, after repayment of any sum or sums already provided by law to be paid from the proceeds of the sale of said lands.
