CHAPTER XXVII. [H. B. No. 130.]

TO PREVENT FRAUD ON INNKEEPERS-PENALTY.

AN ACT for the protection of hotels, boarding houses and lodging houses, and providing a penalty for the violation thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. A person who obtains any food, lodging or accommodation at a hotel, boarding house or lodging house without paying therefor, with intent to defraud the proprietor or manager thereof, or who obtains credit at a hotel, boarding house or lodging house by the use of any false pretense, or who, after obtaining board, lodging or accommodation at a hotel, boarding house or lodging house, absconds or surreptitiously removes his baggage therefrom without paying for his food, lodging or accommodations, is guilty of a midemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than ten dollars (\$10) nor more than fifty dollars (\$50) or imprisonment in county jail not less than ten days nor more than sixty days.
