FOR PAYMENT OF CERTIFICATES OF INDEBTEDNESS.

An ACT providing for the payment of various claims against the State of Washington as evidenced by certificates of indebtedness; making appropriations therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the various funds of the state treasury hereinafter specified, sums for the payment of certificates of indebtedness as as follows, viz.:

Out of the general fund, the sum of twenty-two thousand eight hundred sixty and 10% (\$22,860.82) dollars.

Out of the state normal school building fund, the sum of forty-three hundred fifty-five and 100 (\$4,355.79) dollars.

Out of the military fund the sum of six hundred twenty-nine and $\frac{1}{160}$ (\$629.17) dollars, as per the following items:

ADOPTION OF BALLINGER'S CODE.

An Act to adopt Ballinger's Annotated Statutes and Codes of Washington as an official compilation.
