ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION FOR LEGISLATIVE EXPENSES.

AN ACT making an appropriation for legislative expenses.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That there be appropriated out of the Additional legislative exgeneral fund of the State Treasury the sum of four penses. thousand dollars (\$4,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the purpose of paying expenses of the seventh session of the Legislature.
