CHAPTER XCV.

FOR THE RELIEF OF CERTAIN PERSONS CONTRIBUT-ING TOWARD THE COMPLETION OF ROOMS IN THE STATE NORMAL SCHOOL AT WHATCOM.

AN ACT for the relief of persons contributing money for the completion of certain rooms in the State Normal School at New Whatcom, Washington,

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated Appropriation. out of money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of one thousand six hundred and fiftyfour (\$1,654) dollars, for the relief and payment of the citizens of Whatcom county, Washington, for moneys paid and expended by E. W. Purdy, L. P. White, and Geo. E. Gage, as trustees of said citizens in the completion of certain rooms in the State Normal School at New Whatcom, Washington.

SEC. 2. That the State Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant on the State Treasurer for the money hereby appropriated in favor of E. W. Purdy, L. P. White and Geo. E. Gage, trustees. Passed the Senate March 11, 1901. Passed the House March 14, 1901.

CHAPTER XCVI. [S. B. No. 235.]

RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPENING OF PUBLIC ROADS.

AN ACT amending sections 3774, 3775, 3776, 3777, 3778 and 3779 of Ballinger's Annotated Codes and Statutes of Washington, relating to establishing and opening public roads.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. Section 3774 of Ballinger's Annotated Codes and Statutes of Washington be amended to read as

Pavees.
