APPROPRIATION COVERING MILEAGE AND PER DIEM OF THE FIVE PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS.

AN ACT to appropriate funds for the payment of mileage and per diem of the presidential electors of the State of Washington.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION I. That the sums of five hundred and fifteen dollars and twenty cents be, and the same is hereby appropriated out of the general funds of the State of Washington not otherwise appropriated, to pay the mileage and per diem of the presidential electors of the State of Washington, who were elected as members of the Electoral College of said State, at the November election in the year 1904, and who met at the capital of said State on January 9, 1905, as follows, to-wit:
