## CHAPTER 158.

(H. B. No. 377)

PREVENTING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GIFTS OR COMMISSIONS BY AGENTS, EMPLOYES OR OFFICERS.

AN ACT to prevent the acceptance of gifts, bonuses or commissions by agents, employes and officers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION I. That any agent, employe or factor of any firm, person, association or corporation, or any agent employe or officer of any corporation or municipality, who shall receive or accept any gift, bonus, gratuity, commission or thing of value from any person, firm, association or corporation with whom he shall contract for, or from whom he shall purchase any chattels, goods, wares, merchandise or material for his principal, employer, corporation or municipality, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.
