Marking of packages.

All food packages shall be marked, stenciled or branded on the package in a conspicuous manner with the name of the purporting contents.

CHAPTER 52.

(H. B. No. 28)

PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT OF PREMIUM ON OFFICIAL BONDS OF STATE, COUNTY OR CITY TREASURERS.

AN ACT to provide for the payment by the State or Counties or Cities of the premium or charge on official bonds of State, County or City Treasurers when given by surety companies.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Section I. That the premium or charge for bonds given by surety companies for State treasurers, County treasurers Cities of first, and treasurers of cities of the first, second and third class, second and third class, shall be paid by the State, County or city, respectively:

Provided, That no such premium or charge shall exceed one half of one per cent per annum on the amount of such bond.
