SEC 2. An emergency exists and this act shall take effect <sup>Emergency.</sup> immediately.

## CHAPTER 76.

(S. B. No. 60)

### DONATING CERTAIN SHORE LANDS TO THE CITY OF SEATTLE.

AN ACT donating to the City of Seattle all the shore lands and waters of Green Lake in the City of Seattle, King County, State of Washington.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:*

SECTION 1. That all of the shore lands, beds, and waters of Green Lake, in the City of Seattle, County of King, State of Washington, claimed by the State of Washington, be and the same are hereby donated to the City of Seattle for park, parkway and boulevard purposes: *Provided*, That this act shall not affect the vested rights of upland owners, <sup>Upland owners not affected.</sup> *And provided further*, That the existing ordinances of said city authorizing the use of parts of said shore lands, beds, and waters shall continue in full force in accordance with the terms and conditions thereof.

SEC. 2. The above granted lands shall never be used for any other than park, parkway or boulevard purposes, including suitable street railway facilities. The City of Seattle shall commence the improvement thereof within one year from the taking effect of this act, and within five years from that time shall expend at least \$10,000.00 in such improvements. The title to said lands shall revert to the State in case of the failure of the city to comply with any of the provisions of this section.
