SESSION LAWS, 1905.

Penalty for violations.

SEC. 2. Any person or persons, company or corporation, or any agent of any company or corporation, violating any of the provisions of this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not less than fifty, nor more than five hundred dollars.

CHAPTER 80.

(S. B. No. 112)

TO ESTABLISH A STATE HATCHERY ON THE CHEHALIS RIVER.

AN ACT to establish a State fish hatchery on the Chehalis river, in Lewis County, in the State of Washington.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION I. That the State Fish Commissioner is hereby authorized and directed to prospect the Chehalis river in Lewis County with a view of establishing and maintaining a State salmon hatchery thereon.

SEC. 2. That if after investigation the State Fish Commissioner finds the Chehalis river in Lewis County a suitable stream for the location of a hatchery he is hereby authorized and directed to establish and maintain a State salmon hatchery on said Chehalis river in Lewis County.
