ESTRAYS.

An Act to amend section 3 of an act entitled "An act in relation to estrays, providing for their detention, regulation and sale, and prescribing penalties for its violation," approved February 16, 1905.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Registration by finder.

SECTION 1. That section three of an act entitled "An Act in relation to estrays, providing for their detention, regulation and sale, and prescribing penalties for its violation," approved February 16, 1905, is hereby amended to read as follows: Sec. 3. Any person about whose premises any animal may be in the habit of running at large at any time between the 1st day of October and the 1st day of March east of the Cascade range and between the first day of December and the first day of March, west of the Cascade range, may take up such animal, and shall within ten days thereafter cause the same to be registered with the county auditor of his county under "Estrays Found," giving the information required by the record as fully as practicable, and the auditor shall charge against such estrays the said fee of fifty cents for each animal so registered. Breachy or vicious animals may be taken up and registered as herein provided. The word "Animal" or "Animals" for the purpose of this act, shall include only horses, mules, cattle and hogs.
