CHAPTER 95.

[H. B. 157.]

RELATING TO TIDE LANDS IN FRONT OF VANCOUVER.

An Act relating to the correction of the survey and supplemental plat of the tide and shore lands in front of and adjacent to the city of Vancouver, Washington, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Vancouver tide lands. Section 1. The State Harbor Line Commission is hereby authorized and directed to correct the survey and supplemental plat of the tide and shore lands of the first class along the Columbia river in front of and adjacent to the city of Vancouver, Washington, so that the shore line of said plat shall correspond with the meander line established by the United States government survey.

Emergency.

SEC. 2. An emergency exists and this act shall take effect immediately.
