making such examination to testify in the said cause as to the nature, extent and probable duration of the injury complained of; and the court may in such order direct and determine the time and place of such examination: Provided. This section shall not be construed to prevent any other person or physician from being called and examined as a witness as heretofore.

NEWSPAPERS FOR STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY.

An Act authorizing counties to procure and bind newspapers for the Washington State Historical Society.

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. The boards of county commissioners of the Counties several counties may, in their discretion, acquire without expense, files of not more than three newspapers published in their respective counties and have the same suitably bound and delivered to the Washington State Historical Society for preservation. Said society shall provide for such volumes a place in which they will be readily accessible to the public for examination and for the copying of Use by extracts therefrom.
