FOURTH CLASS CITIES OR TOWNS.

. An Act relating to cities of the fourth class and amending section 7743 of Remington & Ballinger's Annotated Codes and Statutes of Washington.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Section 1. That section 7743 of Rem. & Bal. Code be amended to read as follows:

Section 7743. It shall be the duty of the treas- Duties of urer to receive and safely keep all moneys which shall come into his hands as treasurer, for all of which he shall give duplicate receipts, one of which shall be filed with the clerk. He shall pay out said money on warrants signed by the mayor and countersigned by the clerk, and not otherwise. He shall make monthly settlements with the clerk, and shall receive such compensation as the council by ordinance shall determine.
