Patrolman to sue in own name. thus appointed shall be entitled in his own name to sue for and recover any such unpaid portion in any court of competent jurisdiction.

SALARY OF SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION.

AN ACT fixing the salary of the Superintendent of Public Instruction.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Salary of superintendent. Section 1. The Superintendent of Public Instruction shall receive an annual salary of four thousand dollars (\$4,000.00), payable monthly, upon warrant of the State Auditor, drawn upon the State Treasurer, in the same manner as other state officers are paid.
