DEPARTMENT OF GAME EXPENSES.

An Act making an appropriation for the Department of Game and declaring that this act shall take effect immediately.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Appropriation. Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the state treasury to the credit of the state game fund the sum of fifty thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the department of game for the payment of expenses incurred during the period commencing December 8th, 1932, and ending March 31st, 1933, in carrying out the provisions of Initiative Measure No. 62: *Provided*, That expenditures herefrom shall not exceed revenues actually on hand and available for disbursement from the state game fund.

Effective immediately.

Sec. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take effect immediately.
