CHAPTER 1.

[S. B. 1.]

LEGISLATIVE EXPENSES.

An Acr appropriating the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the expenses of the extraordinary session of the legislature convened December 4, 1933, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That there be and there is hereby ap-Appropriapropriated out of the general fund, the sum of \$75,000. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary to be used for the purpose of paying the expenses of the extraordinary session of the legislature of the State of Washington, convened December 4, 1933.

SEC. 2. This act is necessary for the support of Effective immediately. the state government and shall take effect im-mediately.
